Therefore, companies place a top priority on warehouse safety.

Knowledge of potential warehouse dangers is important to avoiding accidents. Always be alert to potential hazards and ways to lessen risks. Do whatever is required to avoid accidents.

### General Hazards

The most common workplace hazards consist of falls, slips and trips. Accidents like these occur as a result of the employee losing their balance and stumbling over something that has not been correctly put away. Placing or removing things from storage can lead to a slip or fumble, possibly causing both item and worker to fall. The potential for trips, falls and slips is increased when staff are moving supplies on various types of floor surfaces and on various levels. Another common hazard is getting hit by falling things. This is normally caused by failure to properly stack items on shelves and other surfaces. Back injuries because of improper lifting techniques are another common hazard.

Warehouse machines carries inherent hazards. Injuries or accidents can be caused by forklift trucks, conveyors and hand trucks if they are not operated correctly. Warehouse tools, like for example skids, pallets, cutting and strapping tools, must be utilized carefully during loading, packing and unpacking.

Dangerous substances, flammable or combustible materials could pose danger while being stored inside a warehouse. Workers must know how to take steps to protect themselves from health dangers while working around hazardous materials.
