The telehandler or also known as a telescopic handler is similar in numerous ways to a crane and a common forklift. This helpful machinery is constructed with a telescopic boom that can lift upwards and extend forward. A variety of attachments could be connected on the end of the boom, like for example pallet forks, bucket, lift table or muck grab. It is popular in industry and agriculture settings.

The telehandler is a common utilized along with fork attachments to allow the shuttling of loads. Telehandlers have the advantage of being able to reach those inaccessible places which cannot be reached by a common forklift. Telehandlers could remove loads which are palletized from inside a trailer and putting them on places that are high such as rooftops. For certain applications, they could be much more efficient and practical compared to a crane.

When lifting loads that are heavy, the telehandler can experience some instability. As the boom is extended very far with a load, the machine would become more unsteady. Counterweights in the rear help, but don't solve the problem. The lifting capacity rapidly decreases when the working radius increases. Various machinery come together with front outriggers that extend the lifting capacity while the machinery is stationary.
