Cranes come in many various kinds. Every type of crane is used for a particular purpose. Jib cranes are the smallest type, meant for indoor use. Tower cranes are the tallest kind, meant for constructing buildings. In order to access tight spaces, mini-cranes are used. Floating cranes are utilized salvaging operations and oil rig construction on water.

Crane operating procedure would be reviewed everyday during the crane training course session. The implementation of correct overhead material handling measures is included in the course. Proper training means less maintenance expenses and longer equipment lifespan. The course instructs individuals participating in inspection and operating methods focused on all application, including proper rigging and slinging. Those participating can handle important crane components to know the mechanical components. Lifting practices will be demonstrated together with suggested procedures for review by your safety committee. Sessions will include demonstration videos. The crane training course includes a reference and resource manual.

Course content consists of codes pertaining to overhead cranes; machine terminology, attachments and hoists; right inspection ways; essential maintenance requirements and procedures; right sling use.
